Dear TAP readers and unaffiliated Pink Floyd fanatics,

You hold in your hands the official index of The Amazing Pudding fanzine. This publication is intended to be the cornerstone of the complete body of Pink Floyd & Roger Waters reference information. Further information is available from the publications listed in Appendix A.

The Amazing Pudding was started as a fan magazine in 1983 by Ivor Trueman. The Pudding set out to cover Gilmour era Pink Floyd work, leaving Syd material for the sister fanzine Opel. Andy Mabbett began as co-editor in December of 1984, introducing himself in TAP 6, the first annual Christmas Pudding. Readership was small, and all the letter a's leaned to one side, but word was spreading. In Autumn of 1985, Dave Walker joined the staff in time for TAP 13. Dave's wife Carole is ever present with contributions and on the address labels. Ivor ended his association with TAP in late Spring of 1986 to move on to more multi-coloured pastures. TAP 18 was left to Dave and Andy, at which time I also joined on as a contributor and subscriber.

The look of the Pudding began to improve. Issue 19 featured Dave Clarke artwork on the cover, and cleaner typesetting and image reproductions within. Readership increased, fueled by renewed activity from the two developing Floyd camps. Cover art became more intricate yet, much of it supplied by Barbara Kirk. Bruno MacDonald joined as the 3rd editor for issue 24, bringing with him a family of contributors. Issue 26 was the first to make the distinction "The Pink Floyd and Roger Waters Magazine", and was dated November 1987. Issue 29 saw us become "The Original Pink Floyd & Roger Waters Magazine".

As of March 1989, The Amazing Pudding has printed 34 issues. This index should help you find your way around those magazines. I hope you enjoy this resource!

All of the information included in The Amazing Pudding issues 1 through 34 is accessible through this index. Each item has been categorized, and grouped alphabetically within that category. You may wish to skim through the entire index to acquaint yourself with the category headings.

Each item of information is described, and its location in the back issues is provided. The first number is the TAP issue number, followed by the first page on which the item appears. Items which occupy more than one page also have a last page number listed.

Some items may include a "TAP" at the end of the description column. This indicates that the entry was researched and written by a TAP contributor. Most shorter contributions are not so designated, so that each "TAP" entry is certain to contain more detailed information. Photos marked "TAP" are exclusive to the Pudding, and interviews are clearly marked TAP EXCLUSIVE as applicable.

Issues 3, 11, 12, and 14 have page number inconsistencies which may make information hard to locate. The numbers in this index reflect page numbers as they appear, not as they ought to be. Issues 5 and 6 have virtually no page numbers. They are indexed as they ought to appear.

Some items are listed twice under different categories to assist in their location. Common abbreviations are MM (Melody Maker), NME (New Musical Express), CD (Compact Disc), NYC (The Big Apple), LA (City of Angels, Los Angeles). All dates in this version are American Notation: Month/Date/Year.
